Fr. Roy M. Gasnick, O.F.M. +1933

Fr. Roy was a native of Garfield and entered the Franciscan Order in 1953 and ordained in 1960. After teaching English literature at St. Bonaventure University for 6 years, he spent the next 18 years as the founding Director of Communications for the Franciscan Province of the east coast Holy Name Province headquartered in New York City. In 1985 he was named V.P. for Development and Public Relations at Franciscan Communications in Los Angeles. Two years later, he became the Spiritual Assistant for the Secular Franciscans in the mid-south area of the Province for 6 years, residing in Silver Springs, MD and in 1993 he served 12 years as Vicar at the Friary in St. Petersburg. He is survived by several nieces and nephews, 6 great nieces and 6 great nephews.
