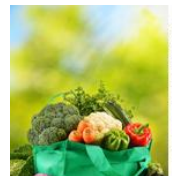

**FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community generously supported the Father English Center food collection on Saturday, October, 24<sup>th</sup> by contributing:

33 frozen dinners	1 frozen ham
48 bags of groceries	5 trays of green tomatoes
7 cartons of canned goods	250 lbs. of rice
2 cartons of fresh vegetables	
50 lbs. of sugar	14 bags of used clothing

These totals include 24 bags of groceries and 50 pounds of rice contributed by our Knights of Columbus Council #240. As well as 9 bags of groceries, 4 frozen dinners and 2 bags of used clothing donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson. Thanks to all who made this food donation possible and particularly to that parishioner who provided 8 frozen dinners with the help of neighbors and friends. The fresh vegetables and tomatoes were provided by our parish's Community Garden.

If you are fortunate enough to sit down to a special dinner this Thanksgiving Day, you will be in a small minority of the world's population. As a matter of fact, there are many people in our own community who suffer from serious food insecurity. Please realize that in ministering to people who don't have enough to eat, we humbly follow in the footsteps of our beloved St. Anthony of Padua. So fervently did St. Anthony take it upon himself to alleviate the suffering of the destitute that he became known as the Patron Saint of the Poor.

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the poor and hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday, November 21<sup>st</sup>.
