**SENIOR CITIZEN IDENTIFICATION CARD**

The Passaic County Sheriff's Office is offering a program for Senior Citizens who desire an Identification Card as proof of residency. Parishioners who are interested in obtaining such a card are asked to pick up an application from the Parish Office as soon as possible. Applicants must be residents of Passaic County, 60 years or older, and have proof of residency and other identification is required. We are sharing this effort with Our Lady of Pompeii Parish.

**CATHOLIC SCHOOL  
SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE**

Due to the generosity of several anonymous donors, St. Bonaventure Church is once again able to offer scholarships to parish children in area Catholic elementary and high schools. Candidates for scholarships are now being considered by a subcommittee of the Pastoral Council of Ministries.

Eligible candidates must meet the following criteria:

- The child is from a family currently registered in the parish.
- The child and his/her family are active in the life of the parish:
  - regular participants at Sunday Mass
  - regular use of weekly offering envelopes
  - involvement in at least one activity or Ministry in the parish.
- The child and his/her family are recognized by the pastor and several other active members of the parish.

Parents or guardians of eligible candidates may now contact the Parish Office. Ask for the ***Catholic School Tuition Subsidy Application***. Decisions for granting scholarships will be made by Labor Day.
