**FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center, on Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. Contributions included:

- 34 frozen dinners
- 38 bags of groceries

- 16 bags of used clothing
- 13 cartons of canned goods
- 210 lbs. of rice
- \$650 in donations
