***From the Pastor's desk....***

August 10 marked the one-year anniversary of my return to St. Bonaventure as pastor after a five-year hiatus. As I review this year, we have accomplished much! Yet, at the same time, some important realities were present and operative but invisible. In the next months I plan to use the bulletin to shine a spotlight on a few items that have not received enough visibility. The first is the Parish Council.

Back in the early 1970s the Parish Council was established at St. Bonaventure when Fr. Severin Brady, O.F.M., was the pastor. The documents of the Second Vatican Council (1963-1965) state that parishioners have a right and duty to express their opinion on what pertains to the good of the Church. Fr. Severin considered it his duty to consult the people for advice. Each pastor after him has acknowledged the skills and wisdom that is truly present among us.

Members of the Council assist the pastor in carrying out our Mission Statement that appears weekly on the front cover of our bulletin. They also serve as the primary consultative body to the pastor. The Council meets five times a year. All members of parish are to be alerted regarding the dates and times of these meetings. All parishioners may come to observe the meeting; only those who are members of the Council may vote on a proposal. I will do my best to alert you to the Council's meetings and the ongoing projects and concerns.
