Annual Corpus Christi Food Collection for the Poor

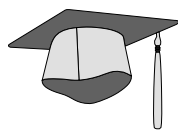
Due to the unprecedented requests

From the Pastor's desk ...

The much anticipated weekend of May 17-18-19 has come and gone. I want to thank our Franciscan friars, Fr. Dan Kenna and Fr. Chris VanHaight, who guided our evaluation and helped us to look to our future as a faith community. I also want to thank everyone – parishioners, non-parishioners, and friend of St. Bon's – who prepared for the Visitation and participated in meetings, meals, and Masses. Our efforts showed well our love for the place and our desire for many more happy years of worship, ministry, and ongoing formation in the Gospel life in a uniquely Franciscan Way!

What's next?

Well, we must wait and wait.... During these next several months, we must find a way to be calm and confident in our waiting. We have done our best up to this time in the process; now it is all in God's hands!

I was most concerned about getting a **timeline** for the resolution of this waiting. I was happy to learn that there is a timeline, in fact, a rather explicit one! Since I want you to know everything I know, this is how it was explained to me: all twenty-nine visitations to ministerial sites up and down the east coast will be completed by the end of September. Reports written by the evaluation teams will be submitted to the Provincial and his Council. That group of eight friars will discuss the reports and make decisions during council meetings in October, November, and December. These meeting usually extend each month three or four days.

On **January 3, 2020**, the Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus, our Province's feast day, the Provincial will connect online with all the friars of the Province on a simulcast. All the friars will be connected with him at the same time. He will then announce the results of the work of the Provincial Council. On that date, we are told that we will know the results of the evaluation process.

We know that we have done the best we could do. Now, it's all in God's hands. And so, until early January, we wait in joyful hope!
