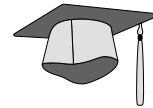
Annual Corpus Christi **Food Collection for the Poor**

FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center on Saturday, May 18th. Contributions included:

- 32 frozen dinners
- 200 lbs. of rice
- 30 bags of groceries
- 2 frozen hams
- 25 cartons of canned goods
- 40 lbs. frozen chicken parts
- 36 bags of used clothing
- 1 carton of glassware
- \$185 in donations

These totals include a \$150 donation to the Community Food Bank of New Jersey for the account of the Fr. English Food Pantry made by our Francis J. O'Byrne Knights of Columbus Council #240, as well as a \$35 donation made by a generous parishioner.

As we look forward to our next collection on Saturday, June 15th, please reflect on the words of St. Anthony of Padua, whose feast day we celebrate in June:

"Today Christ stands at our door and knocks in the person of the poor. It is to Him that we open when we give aid, when we give ourselves to those in need; for He tells us plainly: 'When you did this for one of these least of my brothers, you did it for Me.' "
