FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center on Saturday, May 18th. Contributions included:

32 frozen dinners
200 lbs. of rice

36 bags of used clothing
1 carton of glassware
