## WELCOME FR. MARK

**Fr. Mark Marangone, s.x., a Xaverian Missionary** (St. Francis Xavier Foreign Mission Society), will be preaching the Mission Appeal on August 3 and 4 as part of the annual Missionary Cooperation Plan.

Fr. Mark, born in Italy, was ordained a priest in his hometown (near Udine) in 1984, some 70 miles northeast of Venice and is a graduate of CTU (Catholic Theological Union, at Chicago). After 12 years of service in the USA, first in Wisconsin and then in New Jersey, he did 13 years of missionary work in Colombia (South America). For a couple of years he served in Vocation Ministry in the Capital City of Bogota, and then nine years in “La Encarnacion” Parish, also in view of fostering vocations to the community, first as Associate Pastor, and for the last seven years as its Pastor. He returned to the USA in 2011 to serve as rector of the Xaverian Center at Franklin, WI, and since May 2016 as Provincial Superior in Wayne, NJ.

Being exclusively a foreign mission society, the **Xaverian Missionaries** (Priests and Brothers) depend greatly on proceeds from friends and benefactors. They carry out their service in Bangladesh, Brazil, Burundi, Cameroon, Chad, Colombia, the Democratic Republic of Congo, France, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Mozambique, the Philippines, Sierra Leone, Spain, Taiwan, Thailand, the United Kingdom and the United States.

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2:21-23

"Vanity of vanities." Sometimes we may work for wealth, wisdom and knowledge only to discover that it has been left for some one who did not toil for it. The offering of our work, fatigue and pain, if not for God, can also be a kind of vanity.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

Paul urges us to seek what is good and from God, encouraging us to put our minds on the spiritual. He reminds us that, as Christians, we have died with Christ and are hidden with Christ until his glory is once again revealed. We are all one in Christ.

Gospel: Luke 12:13-21

On being requested to settle a question of inheritance, Jesus heeds us to beware of all covetousness because our life does not consist on the wealth of possessions. Through the lesson of a parable Jesus reinforces this teaching, explaining that those who store up the treasures of wealth and possessions are not the richest in God's eyes.
