## **FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center on Saturday, July 27. Contributions included:

24 frozen dinners  
250 lbs. of rice  
31 bags of groceries  
30 lbs. frozen chicken parts  
14 cartons of canned goods  
1 frozen turkey  
\$150 in donations  
29 bags of used clothing

These totals include a \$150 donation to the NJ Food Bank for the account of the Fr. English Food Pantry made by our Francis J. O'Byrne Knights of Columbus Council #240.

As we look forward to our next collection on Saturday, August 24, please reflect on the words of Mother Teresa :

***" At the end of life we will not be judged by how many diplomas we have received, how much money we have made or how many great things we have done. Rather, we will be judged by " I was hungry, and you gave me something to eat, I was naked and you clothed me. I was homeless, and you took me in." "***
