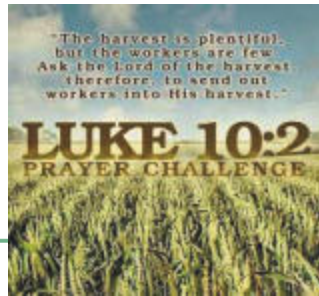

SUNDAY READINGS IN A WORD

FIRST READING

Isaiah 66:10-14c

The prophet said, "Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad because of her, all you who love her....As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you."

RESPONSORIAL PSALM 66:1-3,4-5,6-7,16,20

Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

SECOND READING

Galatians 6:14-18

Paul boasted only in his acceptance of the cross of the Lord Jesus Christ, for upon those who embrace the cross flow the peace and mercy of God.

GOSPEL READING

Luke 10:1-12,17-20

Jesus sent out an additional seventy-two disciples to spread the good news and care for the sick. They were to take nothing with them but to rely on those they served. They were to bring the peace and goodness of God's reign.

FOCUS

The glory and joy of our church, past, present and future lie in the ministry of healing, preaching, and sharing of the Lord's peace. The focus today could be considered evangelical. The first reading and the Psalm echo the sound of rejoicing, a message found in today's gospel: Rejoice that your names are written in heaven.

PRAYER CORNER



As a mother comforts her child, O God, you clasp a broken world to your bosom and send your Son's disciples to bear your gift of peace to all peoples.

Let us go, then, into your harvest not as its masters but as your laborers, seeking not to be successful but only to be faithful, rejoicing that our names are written in heaven.

We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God for ever and ever.

Baptisms and Funerals At St. Charles Borromeo and Resurrection Chapel

All registered members of the Parish of St. Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints are welcomed to have their children baptized in the Parish. If you are recently registered, you may be asked to wait for at least 6 months before your child is baptized. During the period of waiting you are asked to be regular in your attendance at Sunday Mass.

Grandparents, who are the legal guardians of children, are permitted to have children baptized. If they are not legal guardians of children, they cannot request that children be baptized in the Parish. If children are seven years old or older, they may be baptized only after attending Religious Education classes. If you desire baptism for your children, please contact the Parish Secretary.

All registered members of the Parish of St. Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints are welcomed to have Funerals held on their behalf in the Parish. The funeral will be conducted by a Catholic priest and will include a Mass. If the member's family desires, the member's remains may be viewed prior to the Funeral at the Church in a side chapel. We extend the right to a Catholic funeral with a priest to the immediate family of a registered member of the parish, including the member's parents, siblings and children. We do not extend the right to a Catholic funeral to any unregistered person outside the immediate family defined above. Our Church is not available for non-Catholic funerals.

Sí no son los guardianes legales de los niños(as), no pueden solicitar que los niños(as) sean bautizados en la parroquia. Si tienen 7 años o más, pueden ser bautizados solamente después de haber atendido las clases de Educación Religiosa. Si usted desea bautizar a su niño(a), por favor de contactar a la Secretaría de la Parroquia.
