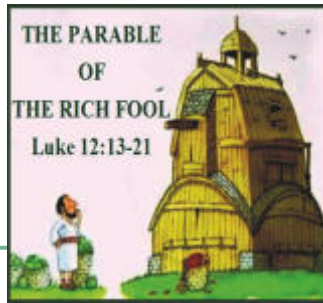

## READINGS, REFLECTIONS AND PRAYERS

### SUNDAY READINGS IN A WORD

#### FIRST READING Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23

"All things are vanity!" Some people have labored skillfully a whole lifetime, but the fruits of their labor go to others who did nothing. What good comes from hard work? Everything is vanity.

#### RESPONSORIAL PSALM 90:3-4,5-6,12-13,14 & 17

**If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.**

#### SECOND READING Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

Since you now belong to Christ, set your heart on things above rather than on things of earth. For in Christ there is not Greek or Jew, slave or free person. "Christ is all and in all."

#### GOSPEL READING Luke 12:13-21

Jesus told a parable about the rich man who stored up all his wealth in order to eat, drink and be merry. God told him, "You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you." In this way Jesus encouraged people to grow rich, not for themselves, but in God's sight.

### FOCUS

"Watch, and be on your guard against avarice of any kind." We are to seek lasting treasures and the wealth that is the gift of God. We must be careful to avoid greed and materialism in all its forms.

### **Renew & Rebuild 2019**

So far \$1.2 Million dollars has been pledged over 5 years to the Renew And Rebuild Campaign. \$173,000 has been received by the Campaign as of July 29, 2019. The Parish has already received \$62,000 as of June, 2019. We will begin using the funds for the sound system at St. Charles Borromeo and at Resurrection. Thank you to all those who have thus far honored their pledges.

### **The New York Child Victims Act 2019**

On August 15, 2019 a One-Year window will open for Civil Suits by those sexually abused as children, previously impeded by the Statute of Limitations, against their perpetrators. The State Legislature voted on this legislation after years of debate and the Governor signed the Act into law earlier this year. Thus, many victims of child sexual abuse by Catholic clergy will be able to bring legal suit against the Archdiocese of New York and other Dioceses in New York , if they have not already addressed their complaints and settled them through the Archdiocesan Reconciliation and Compensation Program. This may mean that cases against clergy who have served our Parish in the past may again be brought to light, although I believe most of the victims in those cases have already addressed their complaints and have already been helped to find a way forward following the trauma of these incidents. The former clergy who have been accused of child sexual abuse at our Parish are currently unable to function as Priests here or elsewhere and are monitored in their movements. Any concerns about these matters should be brought to the attention of Fr. Gregory Chisholm, SJ, the Pastor.

### **The Sanctuary at St Charles Repaired: Monday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, to Sunday, Aug 11<sup>th</sup>**

Starting Monday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, we will not be able to use the Sanctuary at St. Charles Borromeo for worship. The floors will be stripped, sanded and varnished. During the time from Monday, July 29<sup>th</sup> to Sunday, Aug 11<sup>th</sup>, the Sanctuary may not be used for Mass, Funerals or Sacraments. Daily Mass from Monday through Saturday mornings will be held in the Fellowship Room. Sunday Mass, including the Saturday Vigil, on August 4<sup>th</sup> and, very likely, August 11, will be held in the Auditorium. Access to the auditorium of the Church is through the ramp on the western side of the Church or through the Church stairs or through the Church elevator.

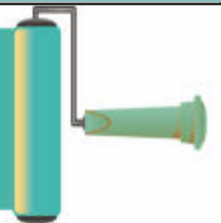
