SUNDAY READINGS IN A WORD

FIRST READING

Wisdom 18:6-9

The people of God awaited the salvation of the just with strong faith. They constantly offered sacrifice according to divine laws and carried out God's word with one accord.

The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin: Aug 14 & Aug 15

This coming week on Wednesday evening and Thursday the Parish will celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin. For all Catholics this Feast is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be available in English at St. Charles Borromeo on Wednesday, at 6:30pm and Thursday at 8:30am. Mass is available at Resurrection Chapel in Spanish on Thursday evening.

The New York Child Victims Act 2019

On August 15, 2019 a One Year window will open for Civil Suits by those sexually abused as children, who were previously impeded by the Statute of Limitations, against their perpetrators. The State Legislature voted on this Act after years of debate and the Governor signed the Act into law earlier this year. Thus, many victims of child sexual abuse by Catholic clergy will be able to bring legal suit against the Archdiocese of New York and other Dioceses in New York, if they have not already addressed their complaints and settled them through the Archdiocesan Reconciliation and Compensation Program. This may mean that cases against clergy who have served our Parish in the past may again be brought to light, although I believe most of the victims in those cases have already addressed their complaints and have already been helped to find a way forward following the trauma of these incidents. The former clergy who have been accused child sexual abuse at our Parish are currently unable to function as Priests here or elsewhere and are monitored in their movements. Any concerns about these matters should be brought to the attention of Fr. Gregory Chisholm, SJ, the Pastor.

Renew & Rebuild 2019

So far \$1.2 Million dollars has been pledged over 5 years to the Renew and Rebuild Campaign. \$173,000 has been received by the Campaign as of July 29, 2019. The Parish has already received the PARISH portion of Renew & Rebuild contributions, about \$62,000 as of June 2019. We will begin using the funds for the sound system at St. Charles Borromeo and at Resurrection. Thank you to all those who have thus far honored their pledges

**Acta 2019 de los(as) Niños(as) Víctimas de Nueva York**

En agosto 15 del 2019 se abrió una ventana de un año para las demandas civiles por aquellos abusados sexualmente de niños, previamente impedidos por el Estatuto de Limitaciones, contra sus autores. La legislatura del estado votó sobre esta legislación después de años de debate y el Gobernador promulgó el acta de la Ley a principios de este año. Así muchas víctimas de abusos sexual infantil por parte del clérigo católico podrá presentar una demanda legal contra la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York, y otras diócesis en Nueva York si aún no ha presentado sus quejas y ha establecido a través del Programa de Reconciliación y Compensación de la Arquidiócesis. Esto puede significar que los casos con contra el clérigo servido en nuestra Parroquia en el pasado pueden volver a aclararse ó salir a la luz, aunque creó que la mayoría de las víctimas de esos casos han presentado sus quejas y han obtenido ayuda para poder encontrar la manera de seguir adelante después del trauma de esos incidentes. Los antiguos clérigos que han sido acusados de abuso sexual infantil en nuestra parroquia actualmente no pueden funcionar como sacerdotes aquí ó en otro lugar y sus movimientos son monitoreados. Cualquier inquietud sobre estos asuntos debe ser presentados al P. Gregory Chisholm, SJ, el Párroco.

**Renew & Rebuilt 2019**

Hasta ahora \$1.2 millón de dólares han sido juramentado por el plazo de 5 años para la campaña de Renew And Rebuilt. Hasta la fecha de julio 29,2019 \$173, 000 han sido recibido para la campaña . 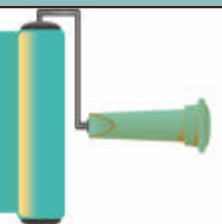
