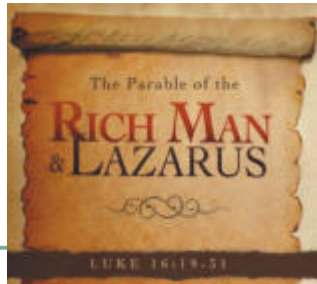

**Renew and Rebuild, August 2019**
