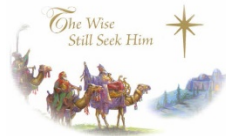

Now Hiring: Emergency Snow Laborers for Winter Season

Snow Laborers Crucial in Clearing Snow and Ice After Big Winter Storms;

New for this Season: Advance Online Registration Required

The New York City Department of Sanitation has announced that registration is now open for those interested in working as Emergency Snow Laborers for the upcoming winter season. Emergency Snow Laborers are per-diem workers who shovel snow and clear ice from bus stops, crosswalks, fire hydrants and step streets around the five boroughs after heavy snowfalls. Snow Laborers earn \$15 per hour to start, and \$22.50 per hour after 40 hours are worked in a week. To better allow for social distancing and COVID-related protocols, those interested in becoming a Snow Laborer must register for a 15-minute application at nyc.gov/snow. To comply with COVID-related safety protocols, potential Snow Laborers should wear a mask or face covering while at the registration appointment. Applicants should not attend the appointment if they have any COVID-19 symptoms, if they recently traveled to a state with high rates of COVID-19 transmission, or if they recently had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

Happy New Year

The Year's end always presents an opportunity to review the life of our Parish community in the light of God's care and protection. In 2020 particularly we must acknowledge the ways in which our Parish has suffered due to fear, restrictions and loss. We can also acknowledge the ways we have been strengthened by God's Grace.

Our parish welcomed new ministers and bid farewell to former ones. Fr. Anthony Iroh, Mr. Mark George and Mr. Dan Faas of St. Charles School made a significant impact on the life of this Parish. Their contributions will be long appreciated. Fr. Czeslaw Wasilewski, SJ joined us for four months from late Winter into Spring working primarily in our School. Fr. Thomas Fenlon, Deacon Ken Radcliffe, as well as Frs. George Quickley, SJ, and James Pierce, SJ, were particularly generous in helping our Parish through the confusion of the last nine months of the year. During the last year Fr. James Goode, OFM, has been unable to participate as a preacher or presider at Masses but he remains attentive and interested in the life of our Parish. We bid farewell to our brother, father and teacher, Fr. Lawrence Lucas, former Pastor of Resurrection Church. Finally, we welcome Fr. George Okeahialam, MSP, who has joined the ministry for the foreseeable future.

Several women in our Parish were celebrated with the first-ever Bakhita Service Awards from the Office of Black Ministry. They included Ms. Tiffany Blake, Sr. Ms Carla Harris, Sr. Dorothy Hall and Ms. Vivian Taylor. The Parish honored Ms. Pearl Emanuel and Mr. Timothy Taylor with Senior Recognition Awards for outstanding contributions to our ministry over many years. The Social Justice Ministry of the Parish stood out this year for their contributions to helping our Civic and Pastoral engagement with Harlem.

The most momentous transition for the ministry of Jesus Christ in our Parish was occasioned by the termination of our Masses due to the Coronavirus pandemic in March. Nevertheless, the New Media Ministry created a new opportunity for our Parish to spread the Good News by developing from nothing our presence on the Internet. Thanks to the efforts of Danielle Beckford, Deacon Michelle Hodge, James Super, Deacon Rodney Beckford and Gerald Adolf with the cooperation BrVon Neal, as well as the musicians and singers of the Parish, we have a public presence on our website, on YouTube and on Facebook.

Fortunately, our large Parish includes many people willing to help out in the midst of adversity. Attached to this note are the names of over 100 people within and outside our Parish who have contributed to helping provide food to those in need at St. Charles and Resurrection. The level of generosity this year has exceeded anything I can remember from past years. Yet the food insecurity of people in the neighborhood of this Church has never before been this great. Thank you also to the St. Vincent de Paul Society and the Father Creavin Pantry at Resurrection for regular and steady commitment to the needs of others.

The Parish also thanks the ten parishioners from both St. Charles and Resurrection who were particularly helpful in developing a strategy for opening our Churches following the shutdown April. Thank you especially to the Ministers of Hospitality at both Churches who have kept us safe at worship. Thank you also for the cooperation of the Lectors, the Eucharistic Ministers and our Altar Servers.
