## **NYC Police Department is Recruiting a Few Good Men and Women**

The New York City Police Department has opened a three-week period of Registration, from April 7th to April 27th, for men and women to take the Police Entrance Exam in June 2021. If you would like to Register for the June Exam, go to [www.nyc.gov/oasys](http://www.nyc.gov/oasys). This opportunity is open to ALL New Yorkers regardless of race, ethnic origins, culture, or sexual orientation.

The NYC Police Department is making a concerted effort to increase the numbers of Black New Yorkers, particularly, among the ranks of New York City Policemen. Currently the Department has 15.5% of its ranks who are Black, even though 25% of New Yorkers are Black. The Department is reaching out to men and women between 17.5 years of age and 35 years of age. ## **The Catholic Church is Looking for Good People Too!**

There are many ways for Catholics to show their commitment to the faith. One way is through giving yourself in service to the community. Catholics can be of service to the worshipping community in many ways. A man can offer himself to God for the community as a Priest. A woman can offer herself to God for the community as a Religious Sister. A layperson can also offer themselves as a Lector, a Eucharistic Minister, a Choir member, a Minister of Hospitality, or a Sacristan.

There is another important way you can serve the Community. A man can offer himself as a **Deacon**. Deacons are usually, but not always, married men. They serve the community at Mass, but they also serve the Community in the help they give at moments of sorrow and joy. Deacons are required to learn the traditions of the Catholic Church in order to help the community on its journey. Deacons are teachers, they visit the sick, they offer advice in times of difficulty, they connect families with the resources that the Church can offer. They are an important help to the Church.

It takes five years to become a Deacon. While studying to become a Deacon a man can continue working and supporting his family. But He has to attend classes sometimes in the evening and sometimes on the weekend. There is the possibility of studying in Spanish to become a Deacon.

### **El Departamento de Policía de la Ciudad de Nueva York está reclutando hombres y mujeres de bien**

El Departamento de Policía de la ciudad de Nueva York ha abierto un período de registro de tres semanas, del 7 al 27 de abril, para que hombres y mujeres tomen el examen de ingreso a la policía en junio de 2021. Si desea registrarse para el examen de junio, visite [www.nyc.gov/oasys](http://www.nyc.gov/oasys). Esta oportunidad está abierta a TODOS los neoyorquinos sin importar su raza, origen étnico, cultura u orientación sexual.

El Departamento de Policía de Nueva York está haciendo un esfuerzo concertado para aumentar el número de neoyorquinos negros, en particular, entre las filas de policías de la ciudad de Nueva York. Actualmente, el 15.5% de sus filas del Departamento son negros, aunque el 25% de los neoyorquinos son negros. El Departamento está llegando a hombres y mujeres de entre 17.5 años y 35 años. ### **¡La Iglesia Católica también está buscando personas de bien!**

Hay muchas formas en que los católicos pueden demostrar su compromiso con la fe. Una forma es entregándose al servicio de la comunidad. Los católicos pueden ayudar a la comunidad de adoración de muchas formas. Un hombre puede ofrecerse a Dios para la comunidad como sacerdote. Una mujer puede ofrecerse a Dios para la comunidad como Hermana Religiosa. Un laico también puede ofrecerse como Lector, Ministro de la Eucaristía, Miembro del Coro, Ministro de Hospitalidad o Sacristán.

Hay otra forma importante en la que puede servir a la comunidad. Un hombre puede ofrecerse a sí mismo como **Diácono**. Los diáconos suelen ser hombres casados, aunque no siempre. Sirven a la comunidad en la Misa, pero también sirven a la Comunidad en la ayuda que brindan en momentos de dolor y alegría. Se requiere que los diáconos aprendan las tradiciones de la Iglesia Católica para ayudar a la comunidad en su camino. Los diáconos son maestros, visitan a los enfermos, ofrecen consejos en momentos de dificultad, conectan a las familias con los recursos que la Iglesia puede ofrecer. Son una ayuda importante para la Iglesia.

Se necesitan cinco años para convertirse en diácono. Mientras estudia para convertirse en diácono, un hombre puede seguir trabajando y manteniendo a su familia. Pero tiene que asistir a clases a veces por la noche y a veces durante el fin de semana. Existe la posibilidad de estudiar en español para convertirse en Diácono.
