Those who have had the opportunity to grow up within a family led by both a mother and a father will know the inestimable value of Fatherhood. They teach us everything from learning to ride bicycles to learning how to be responsible for others. They can be important to teaching boys and girls necessary personal boundaries and important for giving families a sense of safety. Many of us learn how to be competitive from our fathers and at same time they are a welcome source of fun and spontaneity.

From our holy scriptures we understand that it is within God's plan that Fathers are essential to the life of families. As such they are due the respect and honor that today's celebration gives each of them.

Our Next Pastor: Fr. Timothy Wiggins

Born in Valhalla, NY, Father Timothy Wiggins, 57, is the son of Cecelia Johns Wiggins of Port Chester, NY. He grew up in Port Chester in the care of his grandmother, Ms. Beatrice Johns. He graduated from Port Chester High School in 1982. He earned a degree in hotel and restaurant management at the University of Denver, then worked as an assistant director of nutritional services for major corporations, including the Marriott Corporation, and for hospitals, among them St. Joseph's in Yonkers. While working full time, he also put in five years as rectory cook at Our Lady of Mercy in Port Chester; he loved the job and the chance to get to know the priests.

In 1980 he was received into the Roman Catholic Church at Our Lady of Mercy. Even though he had a robust professional career, his heart was in the Church. In his own words, "I saw the need to give, the need to help more people, to be of service. I was already in a service industry, and I wanted to take it to a higher level."

He applied to the St. John Neumann Seminary Residence but delayed awhile out of concern for his grandmother. He spent two years at St. John Neumann Seminary Residence. While studying at St. Joseph's Seminary he taught in the religious education programs at St. Philip Neri in the Bronx and Immaculate Conception in Irvington and visited patients at Our Lady of Mercy Medical Center in the Bronx and Rosary Hill Home in Hawthorne. He served summer assignments at St. Charles Borromeo in Harlem. Fr. Wiggins was ordained on May 18, 2002, at St. Patrick's Cathedral.

He was first assigned as associate pastor at St. Peter's Church in Monticello, NY from 2002-2003. He spent 10 years as an associate pastor at St. John the Evangelist in White Plains until 2013. He was administrator of Our Lady of Mercy for two years. He was assigned as chaplain at Archbishop Stepinac High School in White Plains from 2015 to 2019. He was temporary administer of Our Lady of Sorrows in White Plains most recently.

In his free time, "Father Tim" said he enjoys listening to religious and classical music, singing, taking long walks, and, of course, the one activity that led to priesthood: cooking.

Nuestro Próximo Párroco: P. Timothy Wiggins

Nacido en Valhalla, NY, el Padre Timothy Wiggins, de 57 años, es hijo de Cecelia Johns Wiggins de Port Chester, NY. Creció en Port Chester al cuidado de su abuela, la Sra. Beatrice Johns. Se graduó de Port Chester High School en 1982. Obtuvo un título en administración de hoteles y restaurantes en la Universidad de Denver, luego trabajó como subdirector de servicios nutricionales para grandes corporaciones, incluida Marriott Corporation, y para hospitales, entre ellos St. Joseph en Yonkers. Mientras trabajaba a tiempo completo, también estuvo cinco años como cocinero de la rectoría de Our Lady of Mercy en Port Chester; le encantaba el trabajo y la oportunidad de conocer a los sacerdotes.

En 1980 fue recibido en la Iglesia Católica Romana en Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia. Aunque tenía una sólida carrera profesional, su corazón estaba en la Iglesia. En sus propias palabras, "Vi la necesidad de dar, la necesidad de ayudar a más personas, de estar al servicio. Ya estaba en una industria de servicios y quería llevarla a un nivel superior."

Aplicó la residencia del seminario St. John Neumann, pero se demoró un tiempo debido a la preocupación por su abuela. Pasó dos años en la Residencia del Seminario St. John Neumann. Mientras estudiaba en el Seminario de St. Joseph, enseñó en los programas de educación religiosa en St. Philip Neri en el Bronx e Immaculate Conception en Irvington, y visitó pacientes en el Centro Médico Our Lady of Mercy en el Bronx y Rosary Hill Home en Hawthorne. Sirvió asignaciones de verano en San Carlos Borromeo en Harlem. P. Wiggins fue ordenado sacerdote el 18 de mayo de 2002 en la Catedral de San Patricio.

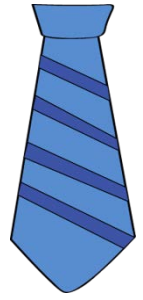
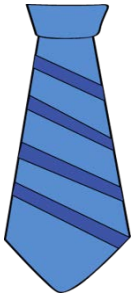

Fue designado como capellán en Archbishop Stepinac High School en White Plains desde 2015 hasta 2019. Recientemente, fue administrador temporal de Our Lady of Sorrows en White Plains.
