

Based on the new and current challenges of the COVID-19 Omicron variant, The Parish of St. Charles Borromeo, Resurrection, and All Saints will be reverting back to our original social distancing plan as follows:

- **Skipping pews and separate seating of individuals and families.**
- **Enforcing the seating occupancy restrictions of 115 at St. Charles and 100 at Resurrection. For the 10 am Mass, additional attendees at St. Charles will be asked to view the Mass in the auditorium on a large screen with sound.**
- **Masks, temperature checks, and hand sanitizing will continue to be required.**
- **Mass reservations are not required.**
- **Holy Communion will be offered in the hands ONLY.**
- **Following each Mass, the congregation should leave the Church immediately so that the sanctuary and body of our churches may be thoroughly cleaned. Bulletins will be distributed after Mass.**

PLEASE follow the Ministers of Hospitality directions.

The above protocols will remain in place and will be reviewed periodically. Further adaptations to Church coronavirus practices will be made when necessary or mandated by the CDC and the Archdiocese.
