Blast from the Past(or) The Third Sunday of Advent December 17, 2017

Rejoice! Joy pervades this Third Sunday known as Gaudete. Wow, auto-correct is simply refusing to let me type 'Gaudete' and I must confess this is making me mutter some colloquialisms universally understood as less-than-joyful. But this is a good lesson for me, because when St. Paul tells us and the Thessalonians to rejoice always, my battle with auto-correct is given perspective. Gaudete celebrates the fact that the Birth of Our Savior is closer than when we first began our Advent journey. God is coming to rescue us! Even if our lives might not resonate with the sentiment of this day right now, this is the joy which transcends our environment, circumstance or situation. At this very moment when the Church exhorts joy, we might be experiencing financial burdens, struggles in health or rifts in the family. Maybe we feel isolated, trapped or simply bored. Or, maybe I am in earshot of Joy Behar's voice, CVS has run out of my favorite Hot Pocket and auto-correct is mocking me. The antidote to all these stressors is The Season itself; a Child. Christmas is about a Baby and lest we forget, in the eyes of God, you too are a child. To recall this is to remember why we must have a Feast! Christmas tells us that joy is the default worldview of a ransomed humanity. Let this joy permeate everything even if we might feel like we are in the depths. Gaudete reiterates that you are God's primary concern. This is Good News. Nietzsche had a point when he said that Christians ought to look more redeemed. Rejoice and celebrate with impunity! The Child to be born is the Savior of the world.

Holiness in Our Daily Lives By Franciscan Media




