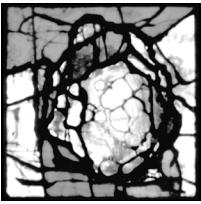

Blast from the Past(or)

**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ
Corpus Christi**

Eating is one of my best ministries. I'm gifted in that way. Not that I'm a big eater, but in 17 years of priesthood, I've been blessed to break bread with so many people. Some with whom I've been invited for meals are self-proclaimed 'clean eaters' who shop small and buy local (I am not sure what that means, but I think it involves bacon, wings, trans fats or salt, so I'm all in. I was once at a parish where someone made me chocolate-covered bacon and I remain convinced that this concoction is the secret to world peace. North Korea negotiations a little tense? Chocolate-covered bacon is a game changer. Can't agree on a tax policy? Chocolate-covered bacon reaches across the aisle. Mets/Phillies animosity got you down? What about the vicious Betty White/Bea Arthur feud? Bloods/Crips? Nothing chocolate-covered bacon can't reconcile). But the dietary consciousness of 'clean eating' is a good thing because it recognizes that our intake effects our health and well-being. So too, exponentially, does the Catholic Meal Par Excellence. Each week we celebrate the Sabbath, to 'do this in memory of Me.' This means that we break bread with each other, feasting on the Passover Lamb. When we say 'Amen' at Holy Communion, we renew our pledge to the Truth of the Incarnation. This is My Body. This is My Blood; poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. How beautiful! But his Meal not only effects our health and well-being. It transforms our bodies and souls. Would that more folks would adhere to this dietary consciousness. The Definitive Meal of the Real Presence is available for you free of charge. It may not establish world peace but 'whoever eats this Bread will never die.....'. I think about my beloved family members who have left their Catholic practices, often wondering, 'did anyone ever tell them what Sunday Mass is'? Mass is where we receive the Body and Blood of Christ! Stay salty, brothers and sisters, and eat well. Thank you, God, for this Bread of Angels.

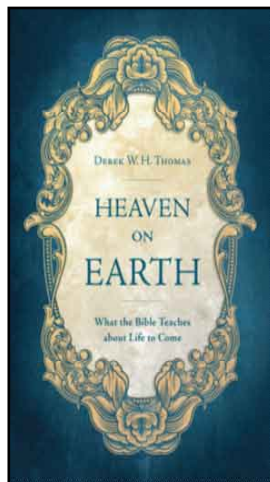

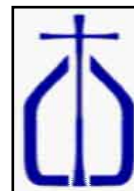

Welcome Our New Pastor

Rev. Vidal Roberto Gonzales Jr.

Rev. Gonzales was born in Kalibo, Aklan, the Philippines, to the late Vidal Dela Cruz Gonzales Sr. and the late Teresita Masangya Roberto.

Educational Background:

- Aklan College (a Catholic institution), the Philippines.
- Bachelor's degree in philosophy with a minor in English and catechetics from Santo Nino Seminary, the Philippines.
- Masters of Divinity from Immaculate Conception Seminary, Seton Hall University, South Orange.

He was ordained to priesthood May 23, 2009 in St. John's Cathedral, Paterson, by Bishop Serratelli. Father Gonzales' first assignment was as parochial vicar at St. Anthony's in Passaic. His next assignment, in 2011, was as parochial vicar at St. Therese's, Succasunna. In 2013, he was named administrator of St. Jude's in Hopatcong, and in 2014 was installed as pastor of St. Jude's by Bishop Serratelli on July 13, 2014. While at St. Jude's, the Bishop also named him as Assistant Vocation Director. Fr. Vidal is also the Consultant of the DCCFM – Diocesan Commission for Catholic Filipino Ministry of the Diocese of Paterson.
