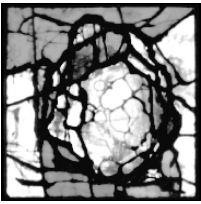

Blast from the Past(or)

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 10, 2018

It's a ritual as old as creation. It's called the 'blame-game' and it is divinely recounted in our first reading where Adam blames 'the Woman' and the woman summarily points her finger at the serpent. Getting 'thrown under the bus' began in Genesis. But this theme memorializes our selfish desire to disavow negative responsibility. I can recall dropping yet another fly ball in little league, only to readily explain to our exasperated coach that the dandelions in the outfield distracted me. We think scapegoating makes us feel better, but as a wise professor told us, 'the first lesson in self-reflection is humility.' Oh boy. That's a fancy way to tell Adam and Eve, and you and me, to 'own it.' That's tough, but liberating love. 'Owning it,' is the beginning stage of Redemption; 'Lord, remember me when you come into Your Kingdom.' As I type, historic scapegoats fly through my mind: Bill Buckner and Mitch Williams (yes, make no mistake, the Red Sox and Phillies' references were delicious and purposeful). Marie Antoinette took a lot of heat during the French Revolution. Yoko Ono still draws the ire from generations of music fans. But the blame game doesn't free us. In fact, it traps us in an Eden yet being rectified. When life unfolds, blame will clamor for our attraction. But we want to get away from Adam's Fault. Today recall what Mother Teresa said when she was asked 'what's wrong with the Church?' She famously replied, 'I am, because I have sinned.' Bam. There's Eden's blame-game slayed. May we accept the necessary cleansing of the Blood of the Savior and recognize that proclaimed in Second Corinthians today, 'everything indeed is for you....'.
