#### Gaining Experience

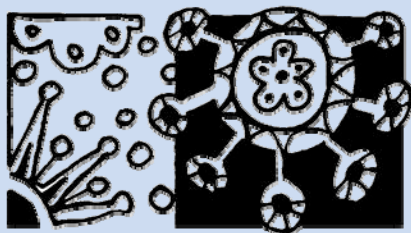
Parents start their job as mothers and fathers with experience. They watched the experience of their own parents, and they see the parenting of their friends. But parents also bring their own experience of growing up. They went through what their kids go through, and they bring that wisdom to the task. As children grow into adolescence, parents often struggle with them. Parents are often sustained by the memory of their own adolescence. When they were younger, they had to go through those difficult years as well.

Jesus also had to gain experience. He was to become the redeemer of the human race, so God saw fit to have Jesus spend time as a human, in order to experience what we do. The Letter to the Hebrews says, "Jesus had to become like his brothers and sisters in every way, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest before God to expiate the sins of the people."

On the Feast of the Presentation, we remember that the parents of Jesus brought him to the temple at the age of forty days. Jesus was God. It should not have been necessary for him to do this. But he did this, and much more, to become like the people he would save. He understands the struggles of parents and teens, of those who are tempted and those who hope for more—because he became one like us.

## Wondering Why

Quick! What date is 40 days after Christmas? Yes, it's today, February 2. And anytime we encounter the number 40 in scripture or church tradition it has to mean something special. So, what is it about February 2 that is special? This is the day we celebrate the Presentation of the Child Jesus at the Temple, and the Purification of Mary his mother. This is an ancient celebration in the church, documented with liturgical texts as far back as the early fourth century, and believed to go back possibly two hundred years before that, maybe even to the end of the very first century.

According to Jewish law, as well as the practice of most ancient religions, the first-born male child belonged to God. In pagan cultures that often meant the child was killed as a sacrificial offering, but since the time of Abraham the Hebrews had forbidden human sacrifice. So, instead, the first-born had to be redeemed, or "bought back" from God by the offering of a substitute sacrifice. A lamb or goat was preferred, but if a family was poor they could sacrifice two turtle doves to buy back the life

of their child. So, according to Luke's Gospel, Mary and Joseph took the baby Jesus to the Temple, purchased the two doves, and presented him in the Temple.

At the same time, the mother of the boy had to go through a ritual purification, a special bath, to cleanse her from uncleanness and restore her to the community of faithful Jews (childbirth rendered a woman ritually unclean.) If the baby had been a girl, the mother had to wait longer for her purification, and no sacrifice was offered.

This story contains a number of ironies. First, the ruler of the universe allows himself to be subjected to the Law. Secondly, the Redeemer of all humanity, is himself ritually redeemed. Thirdly, the woman of total purity, receives ritual purification, and lastly, the Eternal King has only the sacrifice of the very poor to offer. Mary and Joseph were devout Jews. They would follow the Law. They would raise their child to know and honor the Law, and their child would bring transforming Light to the World.

This feast is also sometimes known as Candlemas Day.

Traditionally, people would bring candles from home to the church to be blessed on February 2. This sacramental flows from the words of the Prophet Simeon, an old man in the Temple who recognizes the infant Jesus as the Messiah. Simeon had asked God to allow him to live until he saw the coming of the Messiah. Upon seeing Jesus in his mother's arms, Simeon exclaims "Now, Master, let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory for your people Israel." A light for all nations, hence the blessing and lighting of candles on this day. This short canticle of Simeon continues to be prayed daily at Compline (Night Prayer) in the Liturgy of the Hours.

Besides being an interesting historical moment in the life of the savior, we can use this story for prayerful meditation. Mary and Joseph offered a sacrifice of doves, Jesus offers the sacrifice of his own life – what are each of us willing to sacrifice for him? Mary was ritually purified—of what do each of us need to be purified in our own lives? Simeon, an elderly man had waited his whole life to see the Messiah, and recognized him in the infant of a poor family – when and in whom do we recognize Christ?

Light a candle today, and pray for those who still live in darkness.

Su sacrificio serviría de combustible a la llama que arde y brilla para ser la luz de la revelación para los paganos y para la gloria de Israel.

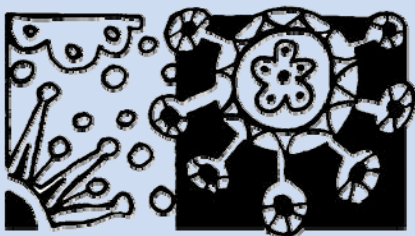


### Servicios a la Comunidad
