Hidden in Plain Sight

Today's Gospel is a familiar story. A large crowd gathers to hear Jesus speak, and

we learn that there were "about five thousand men, not counting women and children" (Matthew 14:21). If all were counted the actual size of the crowd might have been anywhere from double to triple that number. That makes Jesus' feeding of such a large gathering with only five small loaves and two fish a true miracle. Yet the miracle is not simply, as many people think, Jesus performing some sort of superior magic trick to impress us or to fool us. Instead he is pointing to a greater truth for us to ponder, and he uses signs and symbols to get our attention. Signs and symbols surround us. They are a vital part of every human culture, but they vary in meaning from one part of the world to another. For example, the color red often denotes danger in most Western countries; in the East it is the color of celebration. Similarly, a handshake, a bow, an embrace, or a hug all have different interpretations in different cultures. In this Gospel story the feeding of the crowd is a sign of Jesus' power to feed so many with so little, and a symbol of the eucharistic bread we still share today. At the same time, remember that small gem of phrasing in the story that is worth considering—"not counting women and children." This is significant, for many societies today do not consider women or children equal to men. Who does "not count" or is hidden among the crowd in the community of faith? How can we feed those who are starving—for attention, a kind word, a helping hand? What can we do personally that might make all the difference?

Our Christian Service Ministry (CS) helps the less fortunate members of our community and the neighboring communities. Our food distribution every Saturday is the main focus of our Ministry. We collaborate with the Food Bank of Orange County (a.k.a. Second Harvest), to alleviate hunger in our county. Our food assistance (emergency food bags, lunch bags) is a support to low income members of our community, the homeless and those who for one reason or another are having a difficult time in their lives. For others, we provide bus passes or gas cards to provide emergency transportation for a new job or medical appointments. Clothing and other donated goods are passed on to those who can use them. Our back-to-school program, provides back packs and school supplies to students in need. The annual Thanksgiving turkey give-away allows families to come together and enjoy the spirit of Thanksgiving. The December Adopt-a-Family program celebrates the spirit of Christmas. Families in our parish share their blessings by adopting a family who cannot afford to buy new clothes and toys for their children during this season. It is wonderful to see the big smiles on the faces of these families as they receive their gifts.

Christian Service, therefore, is "Faith in Action". We are always inspired by the story of the Good Samaritan, who did not hesitate to help a wounded stranger. In our own little way, we aspire to imitate the Good Samaritan, offering help to strangers and the marginalized of our community. We strive to continue Christ's mission to form a community that prays, shows love and offers services to others.

Weekly Parish Offering

Thank you for your continuing support of St. Norbert Parish. For the fiscal year July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018, our parish budget calls for \$26,470 to be donated weekly at the Sunday collection in order for the Parish to break even. Ocultos y a Simple Vista

El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta una historia que nos es familiar. Una muchedumbre se congregó para escuchar a Jesús hablar y se nos dice que habían “eran unos cinco mil hombres, sin contar mujeres y niños” (Mateo 14:21). Si todos hubiesen sido contados, el número de personas sería el doble, o aun el triple. Darle de comer a esa cantidad tan grande de personas con sólo cinco panes y dos peces es un verdadero milagro de Jesús. Pero el milagro no es, como mucha gente se cree, una gran magia o un truco de Jesús simplemente para impresionarnos o engañarnos. Jesús quiere que reflexionemos sobre una verdad más grande, y utiliza signos y símbolos para llamar nuestra atención. Estamos rodeados de signos y símbolos; ambos son vitales como parte de cualquier cultura humana, pero su significado varía según el lugar del mundo. Por ejemplo, el color rojo en la mayoría de los países occidentales significa peligro; en los países orientales es sinónimo de celebración. De una manera similar, el darse la mano, una inclinación de cabeza o un abrazo tienen diferentes interpretaciones en las diferentes culturas. En este pasaje del Evangelio darle de comer a toda la gente es un signo del poder de Jesús para alimentar a tantos con tan poco; es además, un símbolo del pan eucarístico que aún hoy compartimos. Recuerda también esa corta frase que es como una piedra preciosa en esta historia y que vale la pena considerar: “sin contar a las mujeres y a los niños”. Es algo muy significativo dado que muchas sociedades contemporáneas no consideran a las mujeres y a los niños en igualdad a los hombres. ¿Quiénes son aquellos que “no cuentan” o permanecen ocultos en nuestra comunidad de fe? ¿Cómo podemos alimentar a aquellas personas que están hambrientas . . . , hambrientas de atención, de una palabra amable, de una mano que les ayude? ¿Qué podemos hacer personalmente y como comunidad para aliviar tales situaciones?
