Sunday of the Word of God

Jan. 26, 2020



Pope Francis has declared that the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time will now be known as **Sunday of the Word of God**.

On **Sunday, Jan. 26**, our parish will celebrate this occasion for the first time! This Sunday will give us an opportunity to reflect on the importance of the Word of God for us as Catholics. As Pope Francis

writes, "The relationship between the Risen Lord, the community of believers and sacred Scripture is essential to our identity as Christians. Without the Lord who opens our minds to them, it is impossible to understand the Scriptures in depth. Yet the contrary is equally true: without the Scriptures, the events of the mission of Jesus and of his Church in this world would remain incomprehensible. Hence, Saint Jerome could rightly claim: 'Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.'"

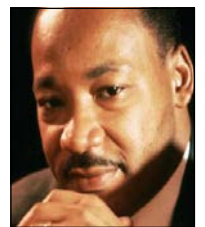

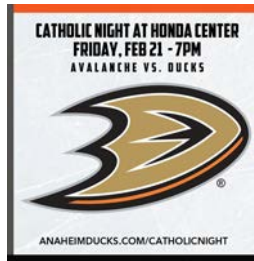
