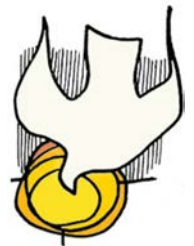

Spread the Word, Not the Flu!

You or people around you may become ill with the flu. Recognize the symptoms and know what to do. Follow these guidelines during a flu outbreak.

1. **Wash your hands often.** Hand washing is one of the most effective ways to prevent transmission of disease. During the flu season, wash your hands more than usual. Always wash your hands after blowing your nose or coughing.
2. **Avoid close contact.** Keep a safe distance from a person who is known to be sick or has symptoms. If you are sick, keep your distance to prevent infecting others and spreading the virus further. Avoid crowds.
3. **Cover your mouth and nose.** Cough or sneeze into your elbow or cover your mouth and nose with a tissue. Immediately throw the tissue into a garbage container and wash your hands.
4. **Avoid touching your eyes, mouth or nose.** Germs are often spread after touching contaminated objects and then touching these areas.

Practice other good health habits. Get plenty of sleep. Be physically active. Manage your stress. Drink plenty of fluids. Eat nutritious food. Disinfect frequently.



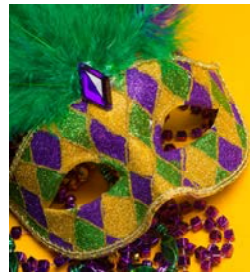
