Dear fellow parishioners:

On July 1, 2019, I was appointed pastor of St. Norbert Parish and have been blessed to return to this dynamic community of disciples of Jesus Christ striving to continue His ministries of prayer, love, and service. For almost 8 months, I have witnessed firsthand the great works of the good people of our parish. Through the hard work of so many people, our various ministries serve the needs of our parishioners and people throughout Orange County. We are truly blessed!

The generosity of 392 households in the 2019 Pastoral Service Appeal (PSA) have allowed us to support the various ministries throughout the Diocese that support the work of the Church in action. As the former Vocations Director of our Diocese, I know how vital and important the financial support PSA provides for those in formation to the priesthood and the diaconate. Our parish has been richly blessed with four men ordained to the Permanent Diaconate this past year. Also, we currently have three men in formation to the priesthood! We can see firsthand what supporting the PSA does.

St. Norbert is our spiritual home and, like many of your own homes, is in need of repairs and revitalization. Our rebates for the last two years have helped to raise enough funds to move forward with our solar project as well as the installation of security cameras for the entire campus. Thank you to all who have contributed to this effort. We are truly blessed!

Our portion of the Diocesan Pastoral Service Appeal this year is \$140,000.00. Over the next year, besides continuing our support of the various ministries the PSA funds, including the formation of the clergy, there are two areas here at St. Norbert where your participation in this year's campaign will help to support:

Building Maintenance and Renovation:

The Church and Ministry Center are in need of a little repair and revitalization. The paint is quite faded and the fascia boards are in need of repair. If not attended to soon, we will certainly look at greater replacement costs in the future. New paint and a fresh look help reflect our pride in our parish.

Adult Faith Formation:

As missionary disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to invite others into a relationship with Him. In order to do so, we need the tools. With your support of the PSA, we can offer seminars and training and invite quest speakers to present on various topics of faith and the family.
