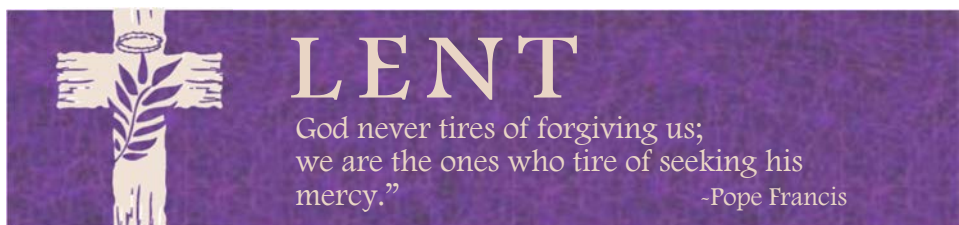

Ministry Center Kitchen Update

Our contractor submitted plans and specifications to the City of Orange and Orange County Health Care Agency to obtain construction permits to repair the damage to the Ministry Center kitchen caused by the fire. During the initial plan checking and permit application review, the city and the county noted that certain elements of the existing exhaust system and fire suppression equipment no longer comply with the current building codes. Our contractor has resubmitted the plans and specifications to the city and county to comply with the current building codes and we anticipate receiving permit approval by the end of March and completing the repairs by the end of April. Our goal is to have a kitchen that meets the current building codes and offers a safe working environment for the many ministries that use it for fundraising and other events.
