



Keep your math skills sharp with IXL!

Research shows that in order for skills to be permanently mastered, they must be continuously practiced. "If you don't use it, you lose it!" To help prevent the summertime "skill slump," all middle school students are being asked to continue using their IXL Math accounts. This site (www.ixl.com) allows students to have a tailored program that practices math skills with feedback and instructional guidelines. As part of your summer math practice, it is expected that you achieve 80% accuracy for each skill. Mrs. Wiant will monitor your usage over the summer and check your completion at the start of school next year.

Our current middle-school students have been given their login information. When you log in to IXL you will see a tab that says "skills suggested by your teacher," this is where you will find the assignments listed below. IXL is a valuable tool that we provide to help students review and extend their math skills as they prepare for the next step in their middle school journey.
