ALTAR SERVER RESPONSIBILITIES-

1. **Training** – Attend all initial training sessions prescribed for Candidate Servers or Altar Servers and subsequent training reviews.
2. **Schedules** – When server is unable to attend an assigned Liturgical Service he/she will first make a reasonable attempt to obtain a replacement.
 - a. **Servers will find** and read Altar Server Schedule in weekly Church bulletin.
 - b. **Servers will be advised** of Christmas, Easter and other special schedules not found in the weekly Church bulletin.
3. **Sacristan** – Servers will act as Sacristans, i.e. will assist the Clergy in preparing and placing necessary items in their proper location for each Liturgy.
4. **Service Participation** – Servers are full members of the congregation and will:
 - a. **Be reverent at all times;**
 - b. **NO gum chewing**
 - c. **Recite prayers and sing** with the congregation;
 - d. **Speak during Mass** only when necessary for the benefit of the service.
5. **Grooming** – Servers will be neatly groomed. **Boys – slacks, brown or black dress shoes. NO Sneakers or sandals. Girls – appropriate church clothes, NO heels, opened toe shoes, sneakers or sandals.**
6. **Arrival** – Servers will arrive in Church Sacristy a minimum of 15 minutes before each appointed service.
