Weekday Mass Schedule:

SC: Wed. at 6pm

Please keep in mind when signing up for Flocknote, that it is the “ST NICHOLAS PARISH” group that sends the majority of messages out regarding pertinent parish information, updates and cancellations. So that is one group that you probably want to join!! In order to do so, you must follow through the process when signing up and make sure you check that group along with any others you are interested in receiving notes from.

Three ways to sign up for Flocknote:

1. Text: stnick to 84576 then follow the prompts and **select the groups that you want to join.**
2. go to: www.stnick.flocknote.com and follow the prompts. **Select the groups you want to join.**
3. go to the homepage of the website and fill in the flocknote form. You may enter your email, cell phone number, or both. **Then follow the prompts and select the groups that you want to join.**

Any way you choose to sign up, be sure to follow all the prompts to complete your sign-up process.

Helpful Hints:

- When you sign up for flocknote and provide an email address, you will receive a verification email in which you need to verify or you will not receive the email flocknotes. It is helpful to add this address (mail.flocknote.com) to your Contacts to avoid emails ending up in your spam folder.
- You cannot enter a landline phone # to your account. If you don't have a cell phone, let that field blank when signing up.
- If two people register, they cannot use the same email address or phone number. Their email and phone numbers MUST be unique to their registration.

How will I receive my messages?

Flocknote Administrators send out messages either by email or text usually depending on the length of the note. If a flocknote was sent by email then you will receive it by email and vice versa. If you only have a cell phone # listed on your account, then all messages will be sent via text to your phone. If you only have an email address registered, then all messages, regardless how they were sent, will be emailed to you.

What if I want to add or leave groups in the future?

Just go to the website and enter your email and/or cell phone # and hit the sign up button and you will connect to the list of groups. You can check or uncheck whichever groups you'd like.
