

*Letter to the Community St. Nicholas and St. Anthony*

*My Children,*

*I can not express to you the joy you have brought to my heart by your diligence to come to my Eucharistic Celebrations. Your faith and trust in me to sustain you in the midst of this pandemic has proven to me your hearts desire to be with me.*

*As my Mother has presented herself to you and the world about the dark days to come, I want you to know that I am gathering my believers around me and they will be blessed with the graces needed to withstand the evil that is has fallen upon the country.*

*My mother has long called for the repentance of all people and this message has fallen on many deaf ears. Because of this lack of true repentance and return to my ways, I have removed the hedge of protection that shielded you from the attacks of evil. In areas where the leadership has been compromised and no longer looks to the care of their flock, evil has almost free reign.*

*This is not so here. Therefore, by your prayers and faith, you continue to repel the enemy but you are weakening. As the days of suffering continue, you are loosing your patience. Your lack of patience is now causing you to turn on each other.*

*You would be wise to remember the words of St. Paul to the Ephesians:*

*“For our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.” (6:12)*

Am I not patient with you and your journey into holiness? Then why do you not accept the place where others are in their journey? Some have more faith than others. If you allow comparison to rule your opinions of others, then you are quick to judge and condemn. Am I to judge you so swiftly?

I have unmasked the true depth of authentic faith within my Church. It has become clear that my church is greatly lacking in faith. Those who have faith, are being tempted to judge those who lack. Those who lack faith are being tempted to shield themselves of judgmental shame, rather than turning to me. There is much grumbling and judgement.

I call you this day, my community, to repent of your judgements and self justifications. I call you draw closer to me and my Mother. It is through the power

of my Holy Spirit that you will be given the strength to withstand the chastisement to come.

No one who is truly a member of my body will escape the suffering that will come. Just as the Israelites who were freed from the bondage of slavery in Egypt had to experience the six plagues, so too will this generation experience my punishment for their lack of response in faith.

Each of you will shown your lacking and your sins against love. In this way, you will return to me and my divine will. Look to the words of Jeremiah 29:11-14a: *“For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the LORD, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope. Then when you call upon me and come and pray to me, I will hear you. When you search for me, you will find me; if you seek me with all your heart, I will let you find me, says the LORD,...”*

I no longer call you to simply obey my commands. I call you to enter and remain in my Kingdom on earth. I call you to see your lives as no longer your own but given to me such that you are no longer your own but mine. In making this choice to be totally united with me you seek to dwell only in my will, which is my kingdom.

Trust in Me, trust in my love for you that did not shy away from death but loves you more than my life. Even though all will suffer, I will bring you through these dark days into the peace of my kingdom. Some will willingly sacrifice greatly for the glory of my Kingdom and I will be in them every step of the way.

As I promised my apostles, I will be with you forever!
