Dear Friends in Christ,

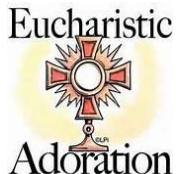
The terrorist attack in Florida on, Sunday June 12th, killing 50 people, and injuring others is a horrible reminder of the presence of evil in the world. Our belief in the Lord reminds us of the words of Jesus in John 16:33 "In the world, you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world."
