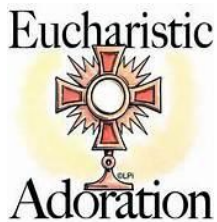

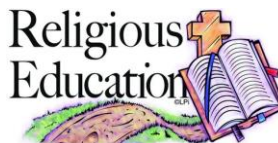
Cursillo Gathering
