

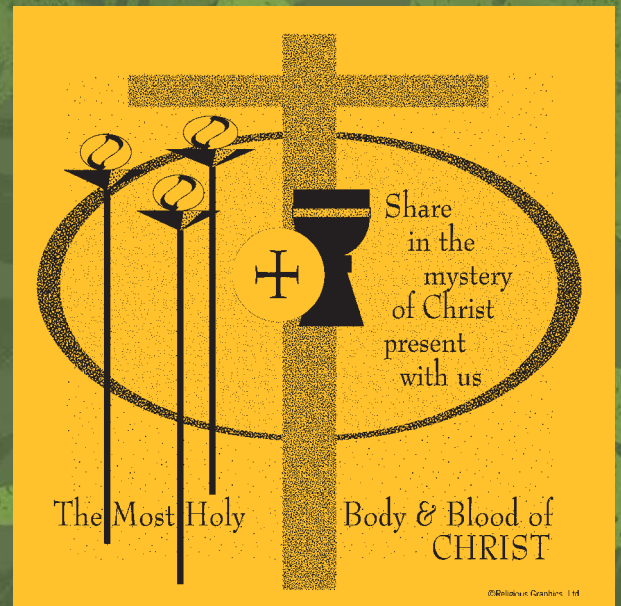

Something to remember . . .

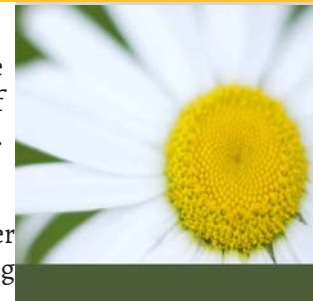

Body & Blood of Christ

First Reading: Genesis 3: 9 -15

Today we are reading from the third chapter of the book of Genesis. This chapter gives a highly symbolic account of the origin and effects of sin. Today's excerpt deals with the effects of sin.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 9: 13 -5.1

When Paul wrote the second letter to the Corinthians, he was probably in his fifties. In the life expectancy back then, only three in every 100 persons lived to be this old. In today's passage, Paul writes about the effects of aging and about death. But because he had experienced the risen Lord, he saw these problems in a different light..

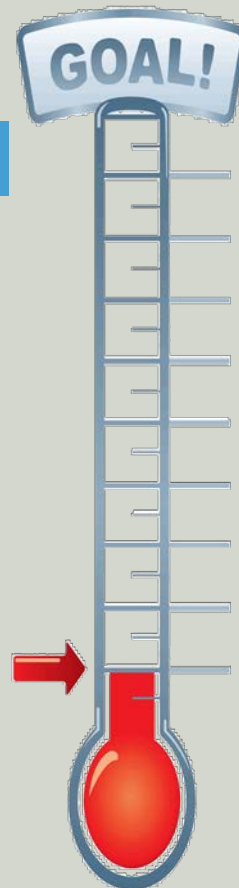
