**SUPPORTING OUR PARISH YOUTH  
SUMMER MISSION TRIP**

*Last weekend, parish Youth Ministry assistant and members of our summer youth mission team invited our support for their work. If you were traveling last weekend and missed it, here are some of Bill's remarks:*

Eight years ago we embarked on a week-long mission with five teenagers. This mission opened our minds and our hearts to the needs of others. As a chaperone, I got to watch the transformation of these teenagers to young men and women. In the seven years of these mission trips we have:

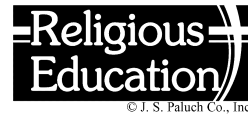
1. Fed over 300 families in South Central Chicago
2. Cleaned graffiti and repaired homes in Yakima, Washington
3. Played with disabled children at a summer camp in Cincinnati, Ohio
4. Worked at a thrift store, warehouse and food kitchen at St Vincent De Paul in Buffalo, NY
5. Did yard work and ministered to AIDS patients in Washington, DC
6. Boarded up homes, retrieved old tires to be recycled into doormats, worked side by side with the homeless in Detroit, MI
7. Worked a farm to provide fresh fruits and vegetables for free to those in Worcester, MA.

Along with experiencing openness to giving, our teens have direct connection with the hardships experienced in today's society (like homelessness, poverty, disability, terminal illness). With these experiences, one of our young adults may find the answer to minimize or even end these hardships.

This year, with 14 teenagers, we head back to Washington, DC. Although we do not know our assignment yet, I know that we will experience some in dire need and bring hope to many we come in contact with.

I welcomed the opportunity to speak to you to explain some details of how we are involved in the mission trips each year. After hearing of all the things we do on these mission trips you might ask yourself: How can we as parishioners get involved too???

On the way out today, take a tube of M&M's; enjoy the treat! Over the next two weeks say prayers for us, placing quarters in the tube for the prayers you offer. In two weeks (April 25-26) please bring the tubes back and place them in the specially-marked container in the church vestibule to help support our mission.
