Although the Religious Education office was closed for the month of August, there was plenty happening and we have a busy and exciting year planned for all levels of Religious Ed. Hidden in Plain Sight: Understanding Adolescent Substance Use and Abuse

Don Bosco Prep will host an exhibit and panel discussion led by the Bergen County Prevention Coalition on Thursday, September 22 at 7:00 pm. This educational event to prevent youth drug use is suitable for parents, educators, other adult community members and any adult who works or cares about young people. A reproduction of a teenager's bedroom will be on display for participants to observe, becoming familiar with where and how teens might hide drugs or paraphernalia. Seemingly innocent items, commonly used by youth, could actually indicate a substance abuse problem. This awareness event will allow adults to be more proactive in helping a young person who might be using alcohol and drugs. Hear from prevention specialists, law enforcement, parents and a young adult in recovery about local drug trends and how to prevent youth substance abuse. Would you be able to recognize signs of substance use and intervene before they become impossible to ignore? Don't leave it to chance! *Due to the nature of this program individuals under the age of 18 and current high school students are not permitted to attend.* The event will take place at Don Bosco Prep, De Sales Hall, 492 N.
