A Message from the Pastor

May 27, 2018
The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity

Dear parishioners,

Last weekend our parish celebrated the confirmation of 37 of our parish teens. It was a great blessing, and wonderful beginning to the weekend! Pentecost too was wonderful, with joyful Masses followed by parish social gatherings on the church steps (organized by our Be My Witness parish ministry).

The end of the weekend brought a different kind of excitement. Sunday night I was going downstairs in the rectory when I saw smoke in the front entranceway. I immediately evacuated Father Don and called 911. We are both fine and nobody was hurt, but it turned out to be a fire in the Youth Ministry office annex (the extension to the front office).

Responders from Allendale and neighboring communities (many of you heard the sirens and sent messages to ask if we were okay!) quickly arrived and the fire was limited to that office, which suffered major damage. The rest of the rectory was spared except for heavy smoke. Fortunately the upstairs residences are still livable, and Father Don and I are able to remain here.

As I write this midweek, we are in the midst of professional “deep cleaning” and insurance analysis. It appears likely that a problem with an extension cord may have triggered the event. Part of the week we had no internet, email or phone service, so I apologize if anyone was trying to reach us unsuccessfully. Our daily Masses were moved to the Church without interruption, and our office staff maintained our regular schedule, dealing with challenging logistics.

I appreciate the offers for assistance we have received, but at this time there does not appear to be anything we need. I simply ask your prayers – gratitude to God that this was not a catastrophe, gratitude for all who helped us, and perseverance and patience for our staff (and me!) in the upcoming weeks and months as we cope with the repairs facing us.

This weekend, on Saturday morning, I plan to be at the Cathedral Basilica to concelebrate as nine men will be ordained to the priesthood for service to the Archdiocese of Newark. They will join more than 700 priests who currently serve the 1.5 million Catholics of the Archdiocese, as well as Catholics and others elsewhere in New Jersey, in the United States, in the US military and in mission duty around the world.

Two of the new priests were born and raised in the New Jersey-New York area; the remaining seven come from Croatia, Colombia, Italy, Poland, and Venezuela. They range in age from 27 to 53. Many have been involved in missionary work, parish ministry, prison ministry, hospital ministry and youth ministry.
