## A Message from the Pastor

January 20, 2019  
Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear parishioners,

Everyone is invited for a "Holy Hour for Life," a special hour of Eucharistic Adoration in the Church on Tuesday January 22 from 8 to 9 p.m. Our time of prayer marks the 46<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court Roe v. Wade decision. You will be joining our Confirmation candidates, who are making this Holy Hour as part of their spiritual formation, during their preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation this May. Our Youth Minister Alex Capicchioni was a participant in this year's annual March for Life in our nation's capital, and invites you to consider joining him next year.

Although we promote a respect for human life through prayer such as this, through outreach like our support for Several Sources Foundation (a local home for pregnant women) and through preaching, we do not currently have a "Respect Life" Ministry. Is this something you could assist with? It is not burdensome. The coordinator and ministry members would help plan or coordinate information-sharing and events with neighboring parishes and the archdiocese.

In October we sent out the annual fiscal report regarding church finances and I spoke about it at all the Masses one weekend. The reality of a \$95,000 deficit last year, and prospects for a deficit this year have already prompted some of you to increase your weekly giving or make special "restricted" gifts to the parish toward needs such as: grounds and maintenance, snow plowing, music ministry and youth ministry. (A "restricted gift" means we use the funds only for that purpose, without it being assessed by the 16% Archdiocesan tax on ordinary parish income.) THANK YOU to all those who have been responding! We are also grateful to those who chose to make a special donation to your parish at Christmas. Your gifts are steps along the way helping us fulfill our parish mission. If you have not yet increased your weekly giving, please consider it.

In addition, I ask you to consider including Guardian Angel parish as a recipient in your last will and testament. As other parishioners have done, this is another valuable long-term way you and your family can support your parish.

I thought you might be interested in knowing some other data that does not show up in a fiscal report. In 2018 we celebrated 23 baptisms here at Guardian Angel. Now, together we must all work to reach out to help young parents raise their children in the faith, to encourage them to join us for Sunday Mass and to make sure they feel welcomed here at Guardian Angel parish. In 2018, our parish celebrated 8 funerals. A funeral Mass is an important way the faithful pray for our deceased loved ones and commend them to God for eternal rest. I hope you will always consider attending a funeral when

If you would like your family to participate in Summer Angel Wings, you must register by Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup>. As of now the dates for Summer Angel Wings are June 26, 27, 28, July 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 & 10, 2019. The hours are 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM. Summer Angel Wings is open to all children who will be in grades 1 – 5 in September 2019.

Children's Church has continued to be very popular this year and after a short break during the Christmas holidays will resume in January. This is an opportunity for young children to participate in a special liturgical experience created just for them.

\*All children in grades K – 3 are invited to participate at 11:30 Mass on Sundays.

\*The children come to Mass and sit with their families at the beginning of Mass.

\*They are then called forward and process with the adult team to the vestibule.

\*For the readings and homily, the children hear the same scripture as the older participants, but the language is on their level.

\*Usually a question and answer period follows the Gospel reading.

\*After a short closing prayer the children return to their families during the offertory to celebrate Mass together.

We hope that your children will participate in this on a regular basis. Since we understand that 11:30 Mass may not be the most convenient time for your family EVERY week, please know that participation in this program does not require a weekly commitment to this particular Mass. We are always looking for adult volunteers to help with this ministry. If this is something that might be of interest to you, please contact the Religious Ed office.

## World Day for Consecrated Life

In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer to celebrate women and men in consecrated life. Since then the universal Church celebrates World Day for Consecrated Life on February 2<sup>nd</sup>. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This Feast is also known as Candlemas Day; the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples.



The consecrated life is one way that men and women live out their baptismal commitment as followers of Jesus. Religious sisters, nuns, brothers, religious priests, and monks consecrate their lives through their profession of the evangelical vows and live as part of a community. Single lay people may choose to be consecrated virgins and make private vows to the local bishop. Secular institutes are another form of living the consecrated life. We thank God for their saying "yes" to their vocation.
