## A Message from the Pastor

May 19, 2019  
Fifth Sunday of Easter

Dear parishioners,

This Sunday afternoon 24 of our young people (and 2 from a neighboring parish) will be confirmed here at Guardian Angel parish. We welcome Newark archdiocese Auxiliary Bishop John Flesey, who will bestow the Sacrament.

One final requirement to demonstrate readiness for the sacrament is for the candidate to write me a letter requesting to be confirmed, and explaining why and what their hopes are. The letters are touching, as many of them share special and personal details about the impact on their lives by Jesus, the Catholic faith, Guardian Angel parish, their catechists, sponsors and families and our Confirmation preparation program. As is my tradition, I'd like to share (anonymously) some of their thoughts from just a sampling of the letters, so that you too might be encouraged in the ways the Holy Spirit is working among and around us!

*The most impactful moment I had this past year with God was on the Confirmation retreat ... with my stronger connection with God I will let him guide me through life, especially in times of trouble.*

*With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, I truly wish to help others understand how much the Catholic faith could benefit them and how little it really needs to conflict with other ideas.*

*Praying and listening to what God is trying to tell us through the Scriptures has really created more of an effect on how I live my everyday life.*

*As Catholics we look to spread love and happiness. We live for others, not for ourselves, and that is a calling worth following.*

*Being confirmed means conscientiously thinking about what Jesus would have done. Instead of jumping into situations, I will carefully look more into it.*

*I want to be confirmed because I would like to deepen and strengthen the relationship that I have with Jesus.*

*The Holy Spirit will help me practice my faith in my everyday life.*

*I especially enjoyed the weekend retreat where I really felt the power of God and his love. I also enjoyed the service hours I've completed with my fellow candidates and had fun along the way.*

*Anyone can go to church on Easter and Christmas, but it takes a true Catholic to take the religion to heart and follow God's word.*

*The world is ever changing and it is nice to know that a strong faith will always lead and bring me in the right direction. When I stand in faith, I do not stand alone.*

*Being confirmed will help me receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit which I feel I can use in many aspects of my future, like the daily challenges I face with school, friends and family.*

*I wish to help the Church grow and spread God's words like his prophets did, and I hope to grow in my discipleship as much as possible.*

### CARING FOR OUR PARISH GROUNDS

We need you! *Did you know: our parish property covers 12 acres!* We do our best to keep it attractive – a place that is welcoming and conducive to prayer, a place that is suitable for our activities and for rental usage, a place that reflects the glory of God's creation and is environmentally responsible. Our parish maintenance employee takes care of the mowing, and I occasionally do some planting and weeding. Some parts of our grounds are cared for by volunteers or special donations – like the landscaping around the prayer garden and pond next to the rectory, the St. Francis prayer garden, and the landscaping around the Barn (Msgr Salemi Hall).



But we could use parish volunteers to assist with weeding and seasonal plantings. Special locations include: the flagpole, the church plaza and island, the two entrance signs, the corner sign, the rectory entrance and alongside the church and auditorium.

## ST. ANTHONY'S FIRST CLASS RELICS

"Afternoon of Hope", a prayerful and holy veneration of the 823 year old First Class Relics of St. Anthony of Padua on Saturday, June 15, 2019 beginning at 2:00 p.m. at Immaculate Conception Church, 900 Darlington Avenue, Mahwah, NJ 07430. These are slivers of skin from his cheek and a fragment of his rib. The relics are on a "World Tour" which began at the Pontifical Basilica of St. Anthony in Padua, Italy where the Saint is buried.

Veneration will begin at 2:00 p.m., a talk on the life of St. Anthony presented by Father Alessandro Ratti, OFM at 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m Vigil Mass with a special prayer and blessing for "Hope and Healing", concelebrated by Fr. Manolo Punzalan and Father Alessandro Ratti, Homilist.

Prayer petition cards and holy cards will be available to everyone. Each prayer petition will be taken back to Padua, Italy by Father Alessandro Ratti on Monday, June 17th. The tour ends back at the tomb of St. Anthony in Padua where the friars will gather and recite prayers over all the prayer petitions and intentions gathered during this tour.
