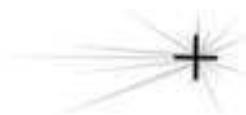

His travels to Kenya, Uganda and the Central African Republic were to produce the same results. It is time for us to respond to the challenge. Through our own prayer and fasting, we too are strengthened to do the work of the elders in our own communities. We do not wait for others to come to us, but we go out to bring the saving message of Jesus to others.

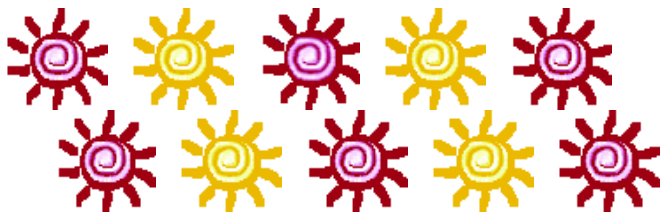
