CHRISTMAS CASH AND STOCKING STUFFER

As you may know we have recently experienced several thefts in and around the parish campus. Sacred Vessels from the cathedral and chapel, thefts from Fr. Dennis' office, and pilfering in the Sacred Heart Center have all occurred. This is requiring a change of our locking system. 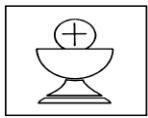
ALL SOULS DAY MASS
