**TO ALL PARISHES**

The Catholic Dioceses of Biloxi and Jackson have taken the lead in rallying the support of faith leaders for the Mississippi Hospital Association (MHA) proposal to extend Medicaid to the working poor of the state. This proposal was the focus of the Catholic Day at the Capitol sponsored by both dioceses last March. Covid-19 has given us a greater awareness of the urgency to pass legislation providing healthcare to the working poor and saving our rural hospitals. We are working closely with the MHA and Working Together (WTJ) to get legislation passed **this June**. Time is short and the need is critical. See link [Letter of Support for MS Cares Plan signed](#) for a Letter of Support providing details of the proposal. It is endorsed by Bishop Kihneman and Bishop Kopacz of the Jackson Diocese along with several other religious leaders. Additionally endorsements are being sought.

WTJ is hosting an important Zoom meeting 6:00 - 7:30 p.m., Thursday, June 4th to learn more and help support this efforts. We anticipate a couple of hundred participants. We need the support of clergy, religious and parishioners. Please spread the word and invite others to attend. **Individual Pre-Registration is required.**

**What does the Lord Require?** This past weekend at the Saturday, 4:00 pm Mass – our Rector, Father Carver spoke about the need for us to “put Jesus” on today’s modern technology. Then at the end of Sunday’s 9 am Mass, I observed one of the congregants that I am close to using her phone to read the Music Liturgy Sheet that we post for use for those who stay at home and stream the Sunday Mass offering. She was using it to sing along with the hymns in person in the Church. After that Mass, she even texted me and professed what she was doing. God answered my question – “What does the Lord Require?”

Starting this week, we will post on the Nativity website a complete Mass Order for each weekend’s Mass. This will not only include the lyrics to the hymns/sacred songs but also the holy scriptures for the weekend. This way folks at home who wish to stream the Mass and those who attend in person can utilize the Liturgy Sheet/Aid. For those who attend in person, you will be able to read/sing/pray along in the service using your cell phone or tablet device. This will continue until the day we will be able to utilize our missals again or unless we are directed to do otherwise.
