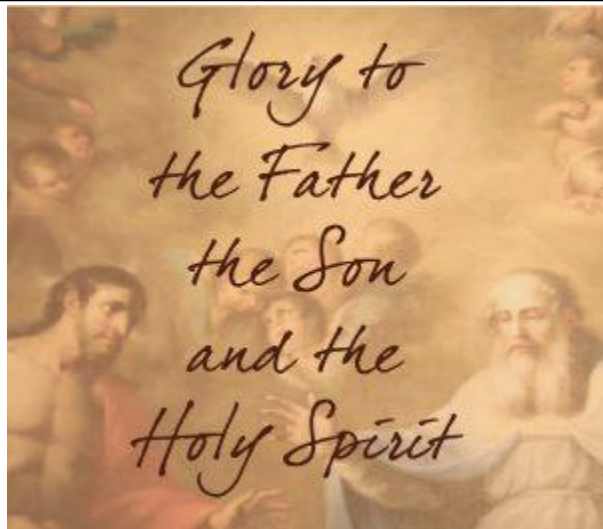

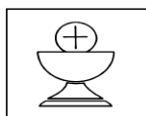

COLORS OF CELEBRATION:

Christians worldwide often wear cloths in the color of blue for this weekend's celebration of Trinity. Blue is the color that symbolizes Divinity. Throughout history blue is considered an unusual color because it was not a "natural" hue. For that reason, the color blue has a mystical association to its use in art. In very early depictions of Mary - she was adorned in the color of pink to symbolize the human and divine connection she has with the Baby Jesus. Later in the Renaissance, Mary is presented in blue and the Baby Jesus in Red presenting her with a pink flower/rose. It would be during this period that blue fully symbolized Divinity and became the color symbol for Trinity. Next week - the celebration of "Corpus Christi" on June 5th & 6th, Christians often wear white or very light - sand colors to represent the "purity" of the "Body of Christ" that we celebrate this weekend.
