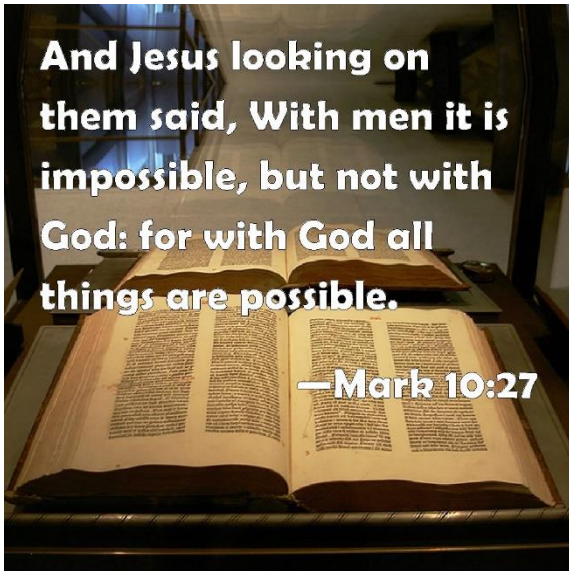

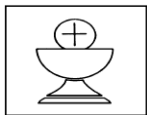
ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES
