It was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925. Our Bishop Kihneman has decreed this to be the "Year of the Eucharist" and we will celebrate with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 10:30 am on Christ the King Sunday – November 21st concluding with Benediction into the 11 am Mass. 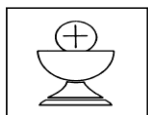
ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES
