My name is Father Martin Bradtke. It is a great joy for me to introduce myself to all of you.

I was born and raised in Poland. My first thoughts to become a priest came to me in high school. In 2007, I joined the seminary in Krakow. I attended and completed my philosophy and theology studies at The Pontifical University of John Paul II in Krakow. After receiving a Master's Degree in Theology, in 2014 I came to the United States to continue my formation and way to the priesthood. First, I was assigned to study English at Rutgers University in Newark. While improving my language skills and relationship with Jesus, I was ordained a Deacon in 2015 and a Priest one year later by Bishop Arthur Serratelli.

My first assignment as Parochial Vicar was at Our Lady of the Lake Parish in Sparta. I have served this community for three years. Now, I am looking forward to becoming a part of this parish community as your Parochial Vicar. Now you are my family, my everything I have here.

Hopefully, the Corpus Christi Food Collection For The Poor will alleviate the annual food shortage. Bishop Serratelli has authorized this Diocesan-wide food collection in all parishes on the ***Feast of Corpus Christi on the weekend of June 22nd & 23rd***.

Unlike most food drives in which parishioners are given a list of items to collect, for this special drive each parish is asked to collect two specific items. The reason for this is to assure we have sufficient quantities of each item. St. Pius X Parish has been asked to provide ***any kind of Canned Beans*** (pinto, black, white) and ***Toilet Paper***.

St. Pius X Organ Fundraiser



The pipe organ, like a congregation, is composed of many unique voices. Singing together they create harmonies that lift us to a worthy praise of God.

The Problem

It has been apparent for some time that our current electronic organ console's electronics has served our church to its' extent. The current instrument has been inoperable since June 2018. The music ministry's ability to support our liturgy relies on an instrument that can properly enliven our worship as we look toward building a better future in our Church.

The Solution

The Peragallo Organ Company of Paterson has designed a new organ to serve as a cornerstone for our music ministry, envisioning an instrument capable of fulfilling the many varied needs of liturgy throughout the year. The instrument is a hybrid combination of pipes and digital technology which combines the centuries' history of the Church with 21st technology.
