## "IF YOU LOVE ME"

Today's first reading centers on "Belonging" - who belongs and who does not. We humans have an innate desire to belong to someone or something. The early church called together it's first Council in Jerusalem to decide the controversy of circumcision. After much debate, searching scripture, and invoking the Holy Spirit, it was "The decision of the Holy Spirit not to place that burden on you" the Gentile Christians. This decision meant the new Gentile converts could now belong to the Church. The wise Apostles understood that it was the "Circumcision of the Heart" that matters. In today's gospel Jesus promises you 3 gifts, if you belong to Him: "(1) I will send you the Advocate and He will teach you everything. (2) I will leave you my Peace, so do not be troubled or afraid. (3) Whoever loves me will keep my Word, my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our dwelling with them." These 3 promises free you from the heartache of not being loved enough, from the need to overdo in order to be loved, and the fear of not belonging. YOU BELONG TO THAT FAITHFUL GROUP CALLED 'BELIEVERS', YOU ARE A CHILD OF GOD AND THE BELOVED OF CHRIST, WHO LOVES YOU UNCONDITIONALLY. ## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

### First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

### Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

### Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.

### 10 SIGNS OF A SAFE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH

1. **Screening** of staff / volunteers.
2. Adults trained in **safe environment strategies** and signs of abuse .
3. **Code of conduct** enforced.
4. **Open Communication** between parents and staff / staff and children / children and parents.
5. **Parents** always **Welcome**.
6. Children educated in **right relationships & what to do if a relationship isn't right.**
7. All children treated with **Dignity and Respect.**
8. **Clear Rules and Expectations.**  
consistent reinforcement / consequences
9. **Adequate supervision of youth.**  
team approach—accountability—no 1:1 isolation
10. All **abuse** is **reported.**
