## “SAVING ARMS”

In our First reading from Kings we find the Lord showing Elijah not to look for God in the loud, flashy and noisy world around him but to listen to the “tiny whispering sounds” deep in one’s own heart. This is usually where you will find the Lord speaking to you. Are you listening? In our second reading we find Saint Paul grieving over his fellow Israelites, the chosen people, who do not believe that Jesus is the prophesied Messiah. He gives witness in his letter to the Romans saying; “my conscience joins with the Holy Spirit, that Christ is God, blessed forever.” You, who believe in the “Good News of Christ,” are God’s chosen people. You must manifest God in today’s world, bringing hope to the hopeless and love to the unlovable. Today, we hear the well known Gospel of Peter walking on water but taking his eyes off of Christ he doubts, becomes afraid and begins to sink. ## NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a

After fleeing from the revenge of the King of Israel, Elijah hid in a cave, but at the command of God, he went outside and stood on a mountain. There the Lord came to him, not in the wind nor in the earthquake, but in a “tiny whispering sound.”

### Second Reading: Romans 9:1-5

Paul is deeply pained because the Jews - in spite of everything that has been given to them - have rejected Christ.

### Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33

Matthew vividly recounts the event of Jesus walking on the water. When the disciples see this, they are terrified, and Jesus chastises them for their fear. Peter begs Christ to let him walk on the water; he is at first brave but begins to sink and loses faith, crying out, “Lord save me!” Christ rescues him for his faltering faith.
