“Jesus said, ‘Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them! For the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.’” --Matthew 19:14

† November 4--Mark 12:28-34

In this week's reading, a teacher asks Jesus which commandment is the most important one. He tells him that the most important is to love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. Jesus also says that the second most important is to love your neighbor as much as you love yourself. How can you show God you love Him with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength? How can you show you love others as much as you love yourself?

† November 11--Mark 12:38-44

Here, Jesus tells his disciples to watch out for teachers of the law. He says that they are given lots of riches on earth but show no respect for the needy. He then shows his disciples how all of the rich men make big shows of their large church donations, but when a poor woman donates her final two coins, he explains that she has given the most out of anybody

there. How can you give to

people who are in need? Is there someone you can help today?

† November 18--Mark 13:24-32

Today's Gospel shows us that nobody except God knows when Jesus will come back, so we all need to be ready for whenever He returns. Ask God to help you be ready for Jesus' return each day. Ask God to show you how to be the very best person He wants you to be each and every day. This way, you will be ready for Jesus when He returns!

† November 25--John 18:33-37

In this scripture, Pilate talks to Jesus and asks if He is the King of the Jews. Jesus answers by telling him that His kingdom is not of this world. He says that he is here to spread and testify to the truth, and that everyone who favors the truth will listen to him. Are you listening to Jesus' message about the truth? He wants you to hear His voice.
