There are 16 classes and each class will cover the content given in the Confirmation Study Guide. This year, since it is the first year using the Confirmation Study Guide, Confirmation II will cover the entire content. Next Year, the content on “God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit” and “The Blessed Virgin Mary” will be taught in Confirmation I and Confirmation II will only be responsible for the content on: “The Church”, “The Seven Sacraments”, “The Ten Commandments” and “The Sevenfold Gifts of the Holy Spirit”.

It is the confirmandi’s responsibility to have read in advance of each class the content in the “Confirmation Study Guide” for that class. The individual lessons “Power Point” as a pdf will be posted each week, as needed.

## **Class Curriculum Schedule**

### **Unit I: God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit**

**Class One:** God Exists; God, Three in One: Love in Relation; The Father: Creator of Heaven and Earth; God the Father Made Me; God the Holy Spirit: Spirit of Love and Truth; The Unified Action of the One God.

**Class Two:** Jesus: True God and True Man; Jesus: Crucified and Risen; Jesus: Ascended into Heaven; Jesus: The Eschaton.

### **Unit II: The Blessed Virgin Mary**

**Class Three:** New Eve & Immaculately Conceived; Perpetual Virgin; Mother of God.

**Class Four:** Mother of the Church; Assumption; Queen of Heaven; Devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

**Class Seven:** The Perfect Society & *Communio*; The Communion of Saints; The Mystical Body of Christ – People of God: The Incarnation of the Word in the World.

**Class Eight:** The Papacy and Bishops; Clergy and Laity.

### **Unit IV: The Seven Sacraments**

**Class Nine:** The Institution of the Sacraments by Jesus; What is a Sacrament?: An Efficacious Sign; Enthusiasm; Effects of a Sacrament: Sacramental Character & Sacramental Grace; Source of the Power of the Sacraments; The Action of Christ.

**Class Ten:** The Easter Sacraments; Baptism (Form, Matter & Minister inclusive); Confirmation (Form, Matter & Minister inclusive).

**Class Eleven:** Eucharist; The Eucharist: Ichthus; Form, Matter & Minister.

**Class Twelve:** Penance (Form, Matter & Minister inclusive); Anointing of the Sick (Form, Matter & Minister inclusive).

**Class Thirteen:** Matrimony.

**Class Fourteen:** Holy Orders (Form, Matter & Minister inclusive); The Sacraments and the Restoration of All Things in Christ.

#### **Unit V: The Ten Commandments**

**Class Fifteen:** All Ten Commandments.

#### **Unit VI: The Sevenfold Gifts of the Holy Spirit**

**Class Sixteen:** All Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit
